





How to fix IP Address for mC-Print 2/3 Model

1. Connect Lan Cable then print self-test out for check the IP Address of the printer, see how to print self-test as below.
 - 1.1 Turn printer off.
 - 1.2 Press and hold 'Feed' button then turn printer on.
 - 1.3 Continue hold 'Feed' button until printer have printed Self-Test out.
